Also when You raised the dead from the netherworld, all the Powers of the heavens were crying out: O Giver of life, Christ our God, glory to You.

FOR ST. PORPHYRIOS, MODE I That offspring of Evvoia and Elder of all of Greece, the mystic of theology and genuine friend of Christ, Porphyrios, was filled with gifts of grace from childhood. So let us honor him. He delivers those oppressed by demons, he cures the sick who shout with faith and gratitude: "Glory to Him who gave you His might; glory to Him who sanctified you; glory to Him who through you is working cures for all."

FOR OUR PATRON SAINT, MODE III All the world has you, its mighty champion, fortifying us in times of danger, and defeating our foes, O Victorious One. So, as you humbled Lyaios's arrogance by giving courage to Nestor in the stadium, thus, O holy Great Martyr Demetrios, to Christ our God pray fervently, beseeching Him to grant us His great mercy.

KONTAKION, MODE III On this day the Virgin Maid goes to the grotto to give birth to the preἔρχεται, ἀποτεκεῖν ἀπορρήτως. Χόρευε ἡ οἰκουμένη ἀκουτισθεῖσα, δόξασον μετὰ Ἀγγέλων καὶ τῶν Ποιμένων, βουληθέντα ἐποφθῆναι, Παιδίον νέον, τὸν πρὸ αἰώνων Θεόν. eternal Word in an ineffable manner. Dance for joy, all the inhabited earth, on hearing. Glorify along with Angels and with theshepherds Him who willed that He appear as a newborn Child, the pre-eternal God.

READING FROM THE APOSTLE: EPHESIANS 6.10-17

Προκείμενον[.] Ισχύς μου καὶ ὕμνησίς μου ὁ Κύριος, καὶ ἐγένετό μοι εἰς σωτηρίαν. Διὰ τοῦτο ἀναλάβετε τὴν πανοπλίαν τοῦ Θεοῦ, ἵνα δυνηθῆτε ἀντιστῆναι ἐν τῆ ἡμέρα τῆ πονηρᾶ καὶ ἅπαντα κατεργασάμενοι στῆναι. Prokeimenon: The Lord is my strength and my song, and He became my salvation.

Verse: *The Lord chastened and corrected me, but He did not give me up to death.* Brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we are not contending against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand, therefore, having girded your loins with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the equipment of the gospel of peace; besides all these, taking the shield of faith, with which you can quench all the flaming darts of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

<u>READING FROM THE GOSPEL: Luke 12.16-21</u>

At that time, as Jesus drew near to Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging; and hearing a multitude going by, he inquired what this meant. They told him, "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by." And he cried, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" And those who were in front rebuked him, telling him to be silent; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" And Jesus stopped, and commanded him to be brought to him; and when he came near, he asked him, "What do you want me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, let me receive my sight."
